

Acceptable Documents for Proof of Idaho Residency

The following documents may be used to prove Idaho residency

- Certified or attested copy of a court order of a federal, state, or county court within the United States that includes the customer's full name, residential address, and date of birth (dated with 12 month of application). Examples include an adoption document, a name change document, or a gender change document
- Home mortgage, lease, or loan contracts with the customer's name, residential address, and signature (dated within 12 months of application). Examples include Retail Installment Sale Agreement, and Motor Vehicle Installment Sale Contract
- Current, valid homeowner's, car or renter's insurance policy with the customer's residential address that is for the current or immediate prior year
- A bank statement or transaction-related document (no more than 60 days old) on a form generated by the issuing bank and displaying the bank's name and mailing address, and the customer's name and residential address, received through mail by the customer
- A checkbook with the customer's preprinted name and residential address
- A utility bill (gas, electric, wired telephone, wired cable, or heating old delivery bill) that contains the customer's name and residential address (no more than 60 days old)
- A property tax or excise tax bill that is for the current or the immediate prior year and contains the customer's name and residential address
- Medicaid correspondence (dated within six month of application)
- Annual Pension or Retirement Statement for the current or immediate prior year
- Annual Social Security Statement for the current or immediate prior year
- W-2 Form from current or previous year that displays residential address
- Cell phone, credit card, doctor, or hospital bill issued within the last 60 days
- Voter registration signed and certified by a city/town official
- Pre-printed pay stub with the employer's name and address and the customer's name and residential address (no more than 60 days old)
- Current Idaho-issued Professional License that displays residential address

- Original letter issued and signed by the principal, headmaster, or official keeper of the records of an Idaho school (including a college or university) on the school's letterhead that states the customer is currently a resident student and includes the name and date of birth (dated within 60 days of application)
- An applicant between the ages of 0 and 18 may submit a notarized statement from his/her parent/legal guardian/responsible party that states the applicant currently resides in the parent/legal guardian/responsible party's house. The statement must include the following:
 - The applicant's name, Social Security number, date of birth, and address
 - The parent/legal guardian/responsible party must meet the Idaho residency requirements for the applicant to be considered an Idaho resident

Need 2 Forms of ID if not using a driver's license.

**For driver's license validation, only require State, License Number, Expiration date
- we do not need to keep a photo copy of the license.**
